elements in advance of the orbit, with the exception of the maxillary, have also been restored, providing a rather remarkable nasal and premaxillary contour. The maxillary appears to be preserved to near its lower anterior extremity.

Edmontosaurus, "Claosaurus" annectens, and Diclonius, Figures 37C; D, and E, respectively, the remaining members of the Hadrosaurina, illustrate well the general tendency in the crestless forms to a lowering of the skull as time progressed.
