
Ottawa, June 29, 1911.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant and note that the Indians will accept \$20.00 per acre for the Right of Way of the Canadian Northern Ry., through the Alexis Indian reserve No. 133. It is presumed that you consider this to be a reasonable sum to demand from the Company.

The name Joseph's reserve is not known in the Department; hereafter be good enough to refer to all Indian reserves by their names and numbers as given in the Schedule, a copy of which has been sent you. The reserves in your Agency are on page 18.
