(b) Approval has been given for the formation in Canada of the following R.C.A.S.C. Sections:-

The formation of the 1st Lt. A.A. Regt. Sec. R.C.A.S.C. was previously authorized on G.O. No. 81 of 1941. The organization of the Unit abroad was deferred and, due to the R.C.A.S.C. reinforcement situation Overseas, it is now to be mobilized in Canada.
