## General Information.

## 1. REDUCED RAILROAD RATES.

The Eastern Passenger Association has granted reduced fares on the certificate plan to delegates attending this Convention.

Delegates will purchase, at their home station, one-way tickets to London, obtaining at the same time from their local agents, receipts on a standard form for the money so paid. These receipts, when validated by the Secretary of the Canadian Cement and Concrete Association, will entitle the holders thereof to return tickets free of charge, provided not less than 300 certificates are presented. A charge of twenty-five cents is made by the Eastern Canadian Passenger Association for the service of issuing the return ticket. A representative of the railways will be present at the Exhibition Hall, Princess Rink.
