JANUARY.—From a collation of the experience of the best agriculturists in various countries, in ancient as well as modern times, it would appear that the regular use of salt in the food of animals tends greatly to promote their growth, and, by strengthening the system, exercises an important influence in the prevention of diseases. English Agricultural Journals have more than once drawn attention to the fact, that a constant supply of salt in moderate doses hastens the development of the colt, and promotes muscular power in the horse, besides rendering the animal less subject to inflammation of the bowels and stomach, indigestion, broken wind, worms, &c. It also preserves oxen from inflammation of the intestines, and acute chronic diseases, typhus and consumption. Salt has also a very beneficial effect on sheep and swine.
