



The highest price was \$700 for Lady Nonpareil 2nd, a roan three-yearold cow, sired by Lovat Champion (imp.), and out of Nonpareil 52nd, a Canadian-bred cow, bred by E. D. Norton, Barrie, Ont. The highest price for a bull was \$1.125, for Village Sultan, a roan two-year-old, by Whitehall Sultan, taken by N. A. Lind, of Iowa.
