RAILWAYS AMOUNTING TO \$60,000,000, THEY HAVE GIVEN ADDITIONAL PROTECTION TO THE STEEL INDUSTRY AND OTHER MANUFACTUR-ERS, THEY HAVE VOTED SEVERAL MILLIONS OF THE PEOPLE'S MONEY FOR USELESS MILITARY DISPLAY, AND THEY HAVE SQUANDERED AND MISUSED THE PUB-LIC FUNDS IN MANY OTHER WAYS.
