Your Committee further report, that the expences of the Legislature continue to be charged as stated in the last Report, against the Acts 33d and 35th Geo. III. jointly, without sufficient authority, and the balance of £6224 1 10 stated last year, is now increased to £8879 14 8. Your Committee concur in opinion with the Report of last year, that this mode of stating the Account should be authosised, and the unappropriated funds generally made chargeable with the expences of the Legislature.

Your Committee further recall the attention of the House to the Report of last year, on the Duties levied at Quebec, under the Acts of 6th Geo. II. and 4th and 6th Geo. III. in which they concur.

On the charges for collecting the Public Revenue, your Committee have to remark, that on the Duties collected under the 14th Geo. III. a deduction is made from the amount of the difference betwixt silver at 5s. 6d stg. per ounce, and the current value, making in the Accounts to 5th January 1812, £594 7 3, and on that of 5th January 1813 £666 10 2, whereas, your Committee have reason to believe, that a great proportion of the Duties collected were paid in Gold and Silver at the current rate, or in Army Bills.
