

And that they had transmitted the same to the Colony Agent, with Instructions to consult the opinion and wishes of Colonel Ready, on the nature and description of the Plate to be presented.

A Message from His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, by Mr. Secretary Collins :

A. W. YOUNG, Lt. Governor.

The Lieutenant Governor lays before His Majesty's Council, the Copy of a Despatch from the Right Honorable Viscount Goderich, transmitting an Order of His Majesty in Council, dated the 22d November, 1830; confirming a Bill passed by the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in the Month of March, 1829—intituled "An Act to regulate the laying out and altering of the Highways, and to provide a mode of obtaining compensation for those who may thereby be injured, and to cause those who are benefited thereby, to contribute towards their formation."

January 12th, 1832.

Ordered, that the said Documents do lie on the Table.

In pursuance of notice, the Honorable *Thomas Heath Haviland* moved for leave to bring in a Bill, relating to the Celebration of Marriages within this Island.

Leave being granted, the said Bill was brought in, and, on motion, received a first reading.
