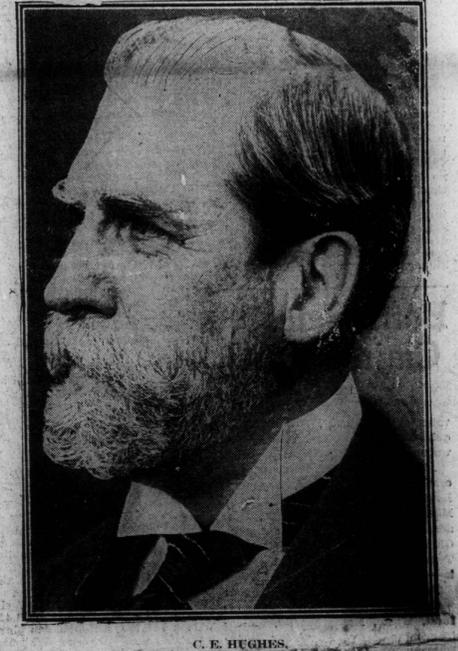


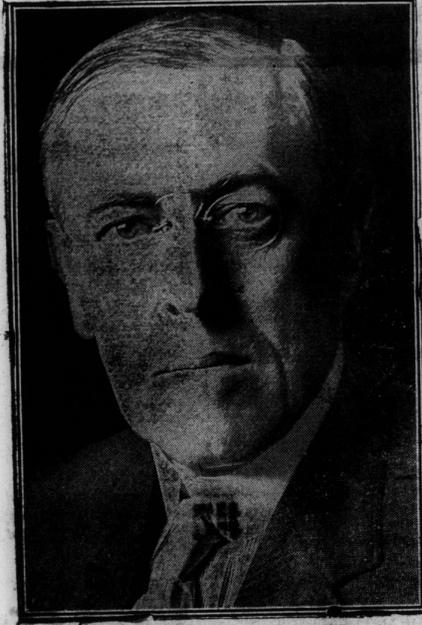
PRESIDENTIAL RESULT IN DOUBT BOTH SIDES CLAIM VICTORY FOR THEIR MAN
