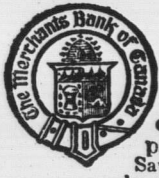

## Womans Institute Items

Do You Know—

That the first Women's Institute that was organized announced that its object was; "to promote that knowledge of household science, which shall lead to the improvement, in household architecture, with special attention to home sanitation, to a

better understanding of the economic and hygienic value of foods and fuel, and to a more scientific care of children with a view to raising the general standard of the health of our people?

That the Provincial Government aids the branch and district institutes financially with grants?

That the Government maintains a provincial headquarters with a super intendant and staff to administer the work and the grants?

That the Government supplies organization experts, lectures to attend meetings and specialists to give instruction in short courses?

That one of these specialists, Miss Alexander of Toronto, is conducting a short course in "Home Nursing" for the Athens Branch of the Women's Institute and that over fifty ladies are in attendance?

That the Women's Institute have established community halls, rest rooms and Libraries in hundreds of Rural centres?

That the Women's Institute Rest room in Brockville is located over the Brock Theatre on Main St. and is open to any Athens women for a very small fee?

That the Women's Institute led the Provincial Government to introduce an effective universal system of Medical inspection for the rural communities of Ontario?

That the Government representative, Dr. Ann Curtin was in Athens last week and discussed the merits of Medical Inspection of Schools with some of the Executive of the local Branch?

That the Athens Women's Institute invites every woman who hopes for the improvement of the homes and betterment of the Community to attend the local Institute and keep along with the good work?
