The supply of wheat, both Fall and Spring, during the past week has been limited; prices remain firm at quotations. Barley is in demand principally for local consumption, and oats bring a ready sale.
Hogs are coming in quantity; the market opened this morning at \$5.00 but before noon \$5.75 was given for a very superior lot belonging to Mr. J. Phin, near Hespeler. This, however, may be regarded as an exceptional price. Packed butter arrives freely, and no less than one or two wagons loaded with this commodity, whose owners had unhitched their horses, in consequence of their early arrival in the morning preventing transactions with the market buyers previous to eleven o'clock. We observed the wood market well supplied throughout the past week, and the demand seems quite equal to the supply.
