ALEX. SHIELDS SUSPENDED.

Brighton Beach, Stewards Find That Logan Was Tampered With—Evidence Against Shields Very Slight.

BRIGHTON BEACH, July 24.—The attendance here today was never large and money was scarce, the weather was pleasant and the track in good condition. The faithful fared well in the first two races, but the result of the third was not so satisfactory to them.

The stewards after investigating the running of Logan yesterday came to the conclusion that the horse had been tampered with, and that some of the bookmakers knew of it.

The evidence against Trainer Alexander Shields being connected with the deal was very slight. It was decided to report the case to the jockey club without prejudice, and pending that decision to suspend Mr. Shields and his entire stable from all racing or being trained on any of the tracks under the supervision of the Jockey Club.

As regards the inconsistent running of W. G. Daly's mare Lizzie, the stewards instructed the secretary of the Brighton Beach Association not to accept her entry again during the meeting.
