A report was in circulation this afternoon that frost is doing considerable injury to wheat in Manitoba.

Consols steady, closing today at 107 3/8 for money and at 107 1/2 for account. Canadian Pacific firm, closing at 70 1/2 today at 68 3/4. St. Paul closed at 72 1/4 at 8 5/8, Reading at 9 3/4 and N.Y.C. at 104 1/8.

Breadstuffs reports a decrease in wheat of 1,300,000 bush since the 27th. In wheat and flour there is an increase of 1,120,000 bush. Total decrease 270,000 bush.
