

a majority of those present decide to hear the member whose conduct is questioned, and may by a majority vote adjourn such special meeting from day to day—no further notice being necessary. Any member censured, expelled or suspended, as aforesaid, shall be immediately furnished, by registered letter, with a copy of such resolution, and such member may at any time, within two weeks after such notice has been forwarded to her, appeal from such decision to a special general meeting of the Club. Six days' notice in writing must be given to each member of such meeting, and the notice must specify the object of the same; twenty-five members shall form a quorum at such meeting, and the decision of three-fifths of those present shall be final.

MEETINGS.

1. The regular meetings of the Club shall be held on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
2. The business meeting of the Club shall be held on the second Monday of each month, followed by a paper, or discussion, according to the printed programme.
3. The time of session shall be from 3.30 to 5 o'clock.
