Ships' binnacle lamps, Sand, Ships' blocks and patent bushes, Shafts for mills and steamboats rough, Spelter in blocks, sheets or pigs, Steel, Steel plates cut, Statues of all kinds natural size, Soda ash, Soda caustic, Soda nitrate of, silicate of, Sulphur in roll or flour, Ships' compasses, dead eyes, deck plugs, iron knees, iron masts, Ships' pumps and gear, iron riders, shackles, sheaves, Ships' signal lamps, steering apparatus, travelling trucks, Ships' wedges, wire-rigging, Sail cloth or canvas, Spikes composition, Straw plaits, tuscan or grass, Stereotype blocks, Skins undressed, Sea grass, Slave, Stone unwrought, Tails undressed, Tanners' bark, Tampico white and black, Tar, Teasles, Tom undressed, Turpentine not spirits, Tobacco, Treenails, Twists silk, Tubes and piping brass, copper or iron, Type metal in blocks, Veneering of wood or ivory, Vitriol blue, Varnish, Whale oil, in casks from ship-board. Animals of all kinds, Barley Bran, Buckwheat, Butter, Cheese, Coal and Coke, Fruits, green and dried, Fish of all kinds and products of fish. Fish oil, Flour of any grain, Gypsum, Hay, Hops, Indian corn, Lard, Oats, Peas and Beans, Plants, trees and shrubs, Poultry, Rye, Salt, Seeds of all kinds, Tallow, Timber and lumber of all kinds unmanufactured, Vegetables including potatoes and other roots, Wheat.

There are also some few special exemptions from duty. A penalty of \$200 attaches to the importation of Books, Prints, &c., of a treasonable, seditious and immoral character; and to counterfeit or base coin.
