

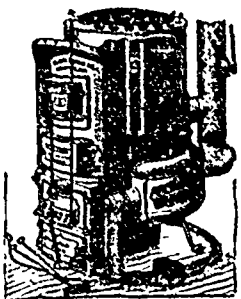

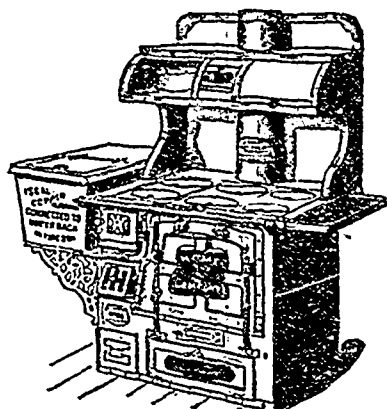

feet above high water. It is of steel and
is supported on 30 piers. The effect is said
