DR. ROBERT ABERDEIN.

Dr. Robert Aberdeen (Tor. '67) died at Syracuse, N.Y., October 18th.

Dr. Gilbert C. Field, of Woodstock, died October 14th.

DR. DAVID S. OLIPHANT.

Dr. David S. Oliphant, of Toronto, died November 13th, aged 88.
