COMMERCIAL.

FLOUR, GRAIN, &c. Flour.—The market is very dull with prices declining on the weak side in sympathy with English advices which report a drop of 8d per quarter in wheat during the past few days and a decline of 18d per sack in flour.

Mill Feed.—Bran is still at \$15.00 to \$15.50 per ton for Manitoba and Ontario. Shorts \$18.00 to \$18.50 and Middlings \$17.50 to \$18.00. Meal is quoted at \$23.00 to \$23.50 per ton as to grade.

PROVISIONS. Pork, Lard, &c.—There has been an improved demand for pork, sales of 3 car loads being reported by one firm at about last week's prices, which however have been held here and there for good sized quantities.

DAIRY PRODUCE. Butter.—New creamery has been placed at the new Eastern Townships at 20c to 22c for good to fine. Old butter is going off fairly well and sales of full creamery have increased at 10c to 12c.

COUNTRY PRODUCE. Eggs.—Sales at 12c to 13c, although 12c is the highest sale reported to us today. Prices here are lower than in the West and a few shipments can be made on a profitable basis.

FRUITS, &c. Apples.—A full jobbing trade is reported at 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 for good to fancy well kept stock, but poor waxy fruit can be bought at from 2 1/2 to 2 3/4 as to condition.

FISH AND OILS. Oils.—Sales of Newfoundland cod oil at 40c, and we quote 40c to 42c, which is an advance upon our last quotations.
