The Premier of St. Vincent to the High Commissioner for Canada

May 8, 1972

YOUR EXCELLENCY:

I have the honour to refer to your Note of April 27, 1972 relating to investments in St. Vincent which would further the development of economic relations between St. Vincent and Canada, and to guarantees of such investments by the Government of Canada, through its agent, the Export Development Corporation.

I have the honour to confirm that the arrangements governing the guarantee of Canadian investment in St. Vincent as contained in your Note meet with the approval of my Government.

Authority to accede to this Agreement has been delegated to the Government of St. Vincent by Her Majesty's Government of the United Kingdom, subject to the condition that the United Kingdom Government should not be under any liability whatsoever in respect of the fulfilment of the provisions of the Agreement by the Government of St. Vincent.

I therefore agree to your proposal that Your Excellency's Note and this reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
