

Mr. Diefenbaker, seconded by Mr. Green, moved,—That this House do approve the installation of a simultaneous translation system in this Chamber and that Mr. Speaker be authorized to make arrangements necessary to install and operate it.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole to consider a certain proposed resolution respecting the development and improvement of the national capital region.

*(In the Committee)*

The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure respecting the development and improvement of the national capital region and in relation thereto,—

1. To provide for the constitution of a National Capital Commission and to repeal the Federal District Commission Act;
2. To provide for the objects, purposes and powers of the Commission; and
3. To enact such financial provisions as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Act.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Diefenbaker, seconded by Mr. Green, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. C-48, An Act respecting the Development and Improvement of the National Capital Region, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The Bill, No. C-26, An Act to incorporate the Lakehead Harbour Commissioners, was considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for consideration of the amendment made by the Senate to Bill No. C-25, An Act to amend The Lake of the Woods Control Board Act, 1921;

Mr. Hamilton (Qu'Appelle), seconded by Mr. Hees, moved,—That the said amendment be now read a second time and concurred in.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The said amendment was accordingly read the second time and concurred in.
