more entered and the journey continued to Ottawa, the capital. After a short stay the party will travel to Montreal, thence along the St. Lawrence to the old city of Quebec.

White Mountains.—Returning from Quebec the next stage of the journey will be to Newport, situated on Lake Memphremagog, and to Fabyans, situated at the foot of Mt. Washington. A few days will be spent at Fabyans, during which the ascent of Mt. Washington will be made.

Home.—From Fabyans the party will go to Saratoga Springs for a few days rest and on September 20th, nearly four months from the time of the departure, the "Maraquita" will roll into the Grand Central Station, having traveled more than 17,000 miles.
