

## RULES.

1.—The meetings of the Band shall be under the control of the Superintendent, who shall have the power to make *Arrangements* and regular *Exercises*, subject to the approval of the other Managers.

2.—The officers of the Band shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Guide, Conductress, and Sentinel, with Male and Female Monitors; the Secretary and Treasurer may be females. The officers shall be chosen from the Band in such a manner as the Board directs.

3.—Young persons (males, between the ages of seven and thirteen; females, seven and sixteen) may, with consent of their parents or guardians, become members of the Band, on being proposed and accepted by a majority vote, subject to the approval of the Managers present. From any such decision an appeal may be made to the Board.

4.—Introduction to membership shall be by taking the pledge, and paying three pence to the funds of the Band, and agreeing to pay one penny monthly on the first regular meeting in each month.

5.—Persons above fifteen years of age may, on being proposed and accepted, become honorary members of the Band, by paying twenty-five cents annually to its treasury.

6.—The Band shall have the power, with the approval of the Managers, of conferring, by vote, privileges of honorary membership on persons who have rendered valuable services to the organization, or to the cause of temperance generally.

7.—Meetings of the Band shall be held at times and places as directed by the Board; such meetings
