Biography

FRANCES Parker was born in Oberlin, Ohio, but her school-days were spent at the Seaforth Collegiate Institute. In 1908 she graduated with honours from the Faculty of Education, Toronto, and for the following two years taught in the Manitoulin Islands. In 1910 her college career began.
