In addition to the foregoing the Corporation has during the year acted as Trustee for the issue of bonds and debentures for a large amount, and has also been appointed Registrar, Transfer Agent, and in other capacities not included in the above summary. The Profit and Loss Statement shows the gross revenues of the Corpora-tion for the year, and plainly sets out the sources from which they were de-rived, and also the charges against the same. The net profits, after making

The net profits, after making provision for every ascertained loss, amount to \$119,732.31, which includes a balance brought forward from the preceding year of \$11,271.20. Out of these net profits your Directors have declared two semi-annual dividends at the rate of 7 1.2 per cent. per annum, amounting to, \$75,000, have written off \$11, 071.55 from the vaults and furnishings of the Head Office and the Ottawa and Winnipeg branches, carrying forward to the credit of Profit and Loss \$8,606.70.

Your Directors announce with deep regret the death of three of their leagues during the past year, viz: the Hon. Senator Fulford and Mr. John Bell, chief counsel of the Grand Trunk Railway in Canada, and Mr. George Gooderham, two of whom showed their appreciation of the aims and objects of the Corporation by appointing it their Executor and Trustee. 
