Peary, who arrived here yesterday, said to-day: "In addition to securing the meteorite, I laid the plans for next year's expedition, and when I leave again, which will be about the end of next July, it will be to remain up there until I reach the Pole or lose my life in the attempt, if it takes five years to accomplish this object."
