MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:—

We beg leave to present to Your Excellency, as Visitor of the University under its Royal Charter, the following report for the educational year ending 31st August, 1900.

Academically, the most important feature of the year's work has been the further development of the new curriculum in Arts. The welcome increase in the number of First Year Students in the session which has just opened seems to augur well for a larger attendance in this Faculty than we have been able to record during recent years.
