MINUTES

OF THE

TORONTO CONFERENCE,

Held in the City of Toronto, Ont.,

JUNE 14th to 22nd, 1882.

THE NINTH SESSION of the TORONTO CONFERENCE was opened in the Elm Street Methodist Church, Toronto, on Wednesday, the 14th day of June, 1882, at 9 a.m. The President, the Rev. John G. Laird, occupied the chair. After the Secretary, Rev. Samuel J. Hunter, had read the 2nd Chapter of the 2nd Epistle of Paul to Timothy, the 753rd hymn was sung, and the Revs. E. Clement, and N. R. Willoughby, M.A., led in prayer.

The Secretary called the Conference Roll, and 174 brethren answered to their names.

The Conference immediately proceeded to the election of a President, whereupon the Rev. ALEXANDER SUTHERLAND, D.D., was elected.

The Rev. WILLIAM H. LAIRD was elected Secretary.

The President, in felicitous terms, acknowledged the honour conferred upon him.

The Secretary in suitable words thanked the Conference.
