REDUCE LUMBER RATES.  
Vancouver, April 15-Freight rates on  
lumber and shingles shipped from Brit-  
ish Columbia to eastern Canada, will be  
reduced commencing April 21, according  
to word received here by railway of-  
ficials.

The reduction will be on all railway  
lines and is the result of a decision on  
the part of the Canadian Railway As-  
sociation to assist Canadian lumbermen  
to compete against lumbermen of the  
southern states. The new rates, it is  
said, will mean a reduction of about  
\$4.80 a thousand feet on lumber shipped  
to Toronto from Vancouver.
