St. John Man's Tragic Fate

Pte. F. B. Campbell Believed
Blown up With Ambulance on
Way to Hospital — Military
News

To have been wounded, carried off the field, and as far as the dressing station and then to have the ambulance in which he was being conveyed down the line, hit by a shell and be blown to pieces was the tragic fate which apparently overtook Private Frederick B. Campbell, of the 26th Battalion, according to information received by his wife at 621 Main street. Private Campbell has been missing since the fighting at Passchendaele Ridge on November 6, and is now officially reported killed. Private Campbell, whose number was 742938, enlisted with the 11th Battalion and was afterwards drafted to the 26th. He had seen considerable fighting with that unit. Mrs. Campbell received a letter from her husband some time ago in which it was stated that her husband had been wounded in the hip and taken to the field dressing station where his wound was attended to. He was then taken on an ambulance which started for the hospital, but the ambulance never reached there and it is supposed that it was struck by a high explosive shell and the stretcher cases were all killed.

Sapper Mayes to Hospital.

official notification that their son, Sapper Frederick Mayes, had been admitted to No. 10 Field Ambulance on the 19th instant, suffering from shell concussion. Led in Sports.

Word of another New Brunswick's brilliant showing in overseas sports comes from Oregon city in the form of a clipping from the Morning Enterprise of that place telling of Kent Wilson winning a French medal and also his victory on contests with the great Overton of Yale and Cross of Chicago. Young Wilson was born at Rexton and takes his name from the county which gave him birth. He is a relative of A. W. Petch, of the mechanical department of the Telegraph.

Stationery Depot.

A district stationery depot is being established in St. John. F. J. Boyle, assistant superintendent of the stationery depot at Ottawa, has been in the city since Tuesday and has been busy throughout the week opening up the depot and completing all the necessary arrangements attached thereto. With the establishment of such an office all the units and services in military district No. 7 will receive their supply of stationery, military forms, etc., from local headquarters where the office will be located. This will do away with the rather round about way of applying to Ottawa as done formerly and in future such requisitions can be met directly through the local branch of the depot. This will bring on a more convenient method of stationery supply.

ST. JOHN OFFICERS WERE ATTACKED

Woodstock, N. B., July 26.—Military officials had some exciting experiences in rounding up deserters near Andover last night. Major Gordon Johnston, Lieutenant McKendrick and Constable Crawford visited the residence of a man named Ayer, after a time the men opened the door and when asked the whereabouts of the deserter he replied that he was in the house. During the night the man returned and was caught by the officers, who were watching for him. Very serious charges were laid against the trio who will have a preliminary examination in a few days. During the trip up river Major Johnston rounded up twenty-two deserters.

Roy Garrison "Mullin" or "Gosline" was tried for indecent assault under the Speedy trial act before Judge Carleton, at Andover yesterday. He was found guilty and visited the penitentiary and twenty lashes. This is the young man who is charged with having committed a series of crimes, including horse stealing and forgery in a space of three days. The attorney-general has been notified of the other charges against the prisoner who will have to face them at the expiration of his sentence.

GLASS FACTORY BURNED
Moncton, N. B., July 26.—The Humphrey's glass factory, a newly established industry here, caught fire during the noon recess. Two buildings were totally destroyed and the plant is a total loss. The damage is placed at \$14,000, with insurance of \$9,500.
