

The recipes for Suet Pudding and To mato Scallop, follows:

Suet Pudding-1 cup finely chopped suet
1/2 cup molasses
1 cup sour milk
2 cups crehem four

1 cup sour milk
2 cups graham flour
1 cup wihte flour
1 cup raisins
1 teaspoon soda
1½ teaspoon salt
½ teaspoon each—
Ginger, Clove, Nutmeg 1 teaspoon cinnamon Mix and sift dry ingredients. Add molasses and milk to suet, combine mix-tures. Turn into buttered mould, cover

Tomato Scallop-1 cup tomatoes cooked and strained.
Put in alternate layers of crumbs and tomatoes with crumbs on top. Put in the oven until brown.

BLUE ARM BANDS FOR CONVALESCENT HEROES

Patients of Military Convalescent Hospitals to Receive Special Badge of Honor

The "Blue Badge of Honor" familiar suffering from disabilities incurred in his country's service, will appear in Canada soon when the 11,988 men on the strength of the Military Hospitals Commission Command will receive blue

It has now become advisable here, as in England, to issue to the men who are patients in the hospitals and at present disqualified for further service, some mark which makes them distinguishable from fresh forces.

The "Blue Badge of Honor" will hereafter enable the public to identify those men who have sacrificed so much for their country's cause and who have not as yet recovered sufficiently to be dis-
