Daily Hints For the Cook

RHUBARB CAKE. One cup sugar, half cup of shortening, one cup of cooked unsweetened rhubarb, one cup of raisins, half teaspoon each of cinnamon and nutmeg, quarter of clove. One level teaspoon of salt, one teaspoon of soda in the rhubarb and turn while foaming over the other ingredients; add two cups of flour; add raisins last; bake in a loaf tin forty-five minutes. CHOCOLATE WAFERS. One and one-half cups butter creamed, two eggs well beaten, two squares of melted chocolate, small piece of soda; add one cup chopped walnuts or bitternut nuts, quarter teaspoon vanilla, half cup pastry flour, pinch salt; drop on buttered tins and bake in quick oven. KIDNEY LA HOTEL. Cut the kidneys in half, remove the fat and skin, place them on a skewer, lay a piece of butter on each and season with pepper and salt. Place in the broiler and cook for three minutes on one side and three minutes on the other side. Fry a few rounds of bread in a little butter, take a tablespoonful of chopped parsley, two teaspoons of butter, salt, pepper and a few drops of lemon juice. Mix well together and form into little balls and place in the centre of the kidney. Cook well and serve on the rounds of bread, with the cut side uppermost.
