New Brunswick.—Letters forwarded every Wednesday and Saturday. Mails close at 4 p m, on the above days. Postage—according to the distance they are conveyed. Newspapers, ½d each.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.—Letters forwarded every Wednesday and Saturday, during the Summer, via Pictou; and on Wednesday only, during the Winter, via Amherst. Mails close at 4 p.m., on the above days. Postage—9d. under half-oz.—and so on. Newspapers 3d each.

Canada.—Letters forwarded every Wednesday and Saturday, by land route. Mails close at 4 p. m. on the above days. Postage—according to the distance they are conveyed; letters may also be forwarded, if specially addressed, by the steam-packets via Boston—postage 1s 1½d under half-oz., and so on, which must be prepaid. Newspapers by land-mail, ½d—by packet, 2½d.

Newfoundland.—Mails are made up one hour after the arrival of the steam-packet from Boston, during the months May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December; and two hours after the arrival of the steam-packet from Liverpool, during the months of January, February, March, and April. Postage, 42d under half-oz., and so on. Newspapers, free.

ST. PIERRE AND MIQUELON.—Letters must be prepaid, forwarded by French Packet from Halifax once a month. Postage, 4½d under doz, and so on. Newspapers, 1d each.

United Kingdom.—Letters forwarded by steam-packets from Halifax. Postage, 1s 1½d, under half-oz. and so on—payment optional. The Mail is primarily closed at 9 p. m. on the 2d and 17th of May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December; and on the 2d January, February, March, and April; unpaid letters, however, may be put into the letter-box until her arrival, and should the packet not have arrived by 9 p. m. on the mornings of the 3rd and 18th, paid letters will be received until her arrival. When the 3rd or 18th falls on Sunday, the office will not be open for the receipt of paid letters until after the packet is reported in the offing; when the 2d and 17th falls on Sunday, the office will be open for the receipt of paid letters from nine to 11 a.m., and from 5 to 9 p.m. Newspapers, free.

BERMUDA.—Mails are made up two hours after the arrival of the steam-packet at Halifax, from Liverpool. Postage—4½d under half-oz. and so on—paid or unpaid. Newspapers, free.

West Indies (British).—Letters forwarded via Bermuda—postage 4½d under half-oz.—payment optional; or via Southampton, postage 2s. 3d. under half-oz., and so on. To Jamaica and Berbice, (the port of Kingston excepted), the postage is 2s. 5d. under half-oz. and so on. Newspapers, free.

UNITED STATES.—Letters must be *prepaid* forwarded via St. John. Mail closes on Wednesday and Saturday, at 4 p.m. Postage, 1s. 1½d under ½ oz. and so on. Letters may also be forwarded by steam-packet. Mail closes 1 hour after her arrival from Liverpool, G. B.; postage 1s. 1½d under half-oz. must be paid. Newspapers, via St. John, 1d. By steam-packet, 2½d. each.

HAVANA.—Letters must be prepaid, forwarded via Bermuda; postage, 1s 1½d uuder ½ oz.; or via Southampton, postage 3s 7½d under half oz. and so on. Newspapers, 2½d each.
