**Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.**  
 The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, who was at the commencement of the present year, and has not been previously adjudged a subject of an allied or neutral country, is eligible to be a settler in the Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for Districts, and cultivate 50 acres or more on certain conditions. Duties--Six months residence upon and cultivation of land in each of three years.  
 A settler after obtaining homestead patent if he cannot secure a pre-emption, may take a purchase homestead in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Must reside six months in each of three years after securing homestead patent and cultivate 50 acres or more. May obtain pre-emption patent as soon as homestead patent on certain conditions.  
 Settlers of native or foreign birth, who have never been in Canada during 1917, or reside in Canada under certain conditions, are eligible to take a purchase homestead. Pre-emption patent may be taken in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Must reside six months in each of three years after securing homestead patent and cultivate 50 acres or more. May obtain pre-emption patent as soon as homestead patent on certain conditions.  
 Holders of native or foreign birth, who have never been in Canada during 1917, or reside in Canada under certain conditions, are eligible to take a purchase homestead. Pre-emption patent may be taken in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Must reside six months in each of three years after securing homestead patent and cultivate 50 acres or more. May obtain pre-emption patent as soon as homestead patent on certain conditions.
