Council subsequently until resignation of Cabinet, 20 Dec., 1872. Represented Douglas and Lillooet in first Legislative Council of B.C. and V.I., from 1868 until Confederation with Can., 1870. Returned for present seat, by acclamation, at g.e., 1871. — *Columbia St., New Westminster.*
