

BILL.

An Act to repeal certain provisions of an Act passed in the last Session of the Provincial Parliament, and intituled, "An Act to consolidate the " laws relative to the powers and duties of the Trinity " House of Quebec, and for other purposes," and to exempt Masters of Vessels belonging to the District of Quebec from taking Pilots in certain cases.

HEREAS it is expedient to exempt Masters and Preamble. persons having charge of vessels belonging to the District of Quebec from the obligation to take Branch Pilots to pilot such vessels within the limits of the Port 5 of Quebec, in certain cases: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Secondly,-That from and after the passing of this Act, Master to have 20 every Master or person in charge of a vessel belonging all the powers to any place in the District of Quebec, when navigating Flot such vessel between the Port of Quebec and any Port in the British Possessions aforesaid, shall, as regards the conduct and management of such vessel within the Port of

25 Quebec, have all the powers which are by any law or usage possessed by any Branch Pilot : any law, ordinance, rule, or regulation to the contrary notwithstanding.
