In reply to your letter, of the 9th. inst. and prior correspondence, beg to advise that I have on two occasions, appealed to the Council, of the Walpole Island Band to pass a Resolution, locating Wm. C. Johnson, on Lot, No. 266, Block, H. Walpole Island. The Council on both occasions, refused to pass a favourable resolution, giving as a reason, that as Wm. Johnson, had acquired this Property, under the Soldier Settlement Act, that this Lot, would cease to be part of the Reserve, and might eventually be sold to a White Man. I am inclosing Duplicate, Location Ticket, No. 2746, the Original, being on File, at the Department.
