- 1. Mr. Turnbull has, and will hand to the Prime Minister before he goes into the House, the message, in English and French, from His Excellency, regarding the Commission of Internal Economy.
- 2. I am sending herewith Mr. King's copy of the emergency Orders-in-Council which are to be tabled in House and Senate this afternoon. 3 copies for tabling will be handed the Prime Minister by Mr. Turnbull, before he goes into the House.
- 3. Copies, in English and French, of the White Paper, which is to be tabled in the House and Senate this afternoon, will be handed the Prime Minister by Mr. Turnbull, before he goes into the House. (Copies not yet received from press).
- 4. The Prime Minister's copy of the procedure for this afternoon, together with motions, etc., and a copy of the two letters re Mr. Dunning and the letter from the King have been sent to Laurier House. You should endeavour to ensure that the Prime Minister takes these with him to the House. (Copies of the same are in the possession of Mr. Turnbull in 212).
