



Ottawa May 19, 1908.

Sir,-

In connection with a letter addressed to you on the 4th instant relating to the killing of cattle on the ferry Island Indian Reserve by trains of the Grand Trunk Railway, I have the honor to inform you that the Indian Council has preferred a second and very urgent request to the effect that your Company shall remove the fences and stop the cattle along the right of way and at the last at Depot Harbour. I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to issue instructions to have this matter attended to with as little delay as possible.
