



Ottawa, May 3, 1907.

Sir,-

Referring to telegram addressed you yesterday advising of withdrawal from the market of the unsold lands in your agency, and instructing you not to make any more sales or accept any more applications for land until further advised, I beg to say that it has been decided to have a re-examination and re-valuation of the unsold lands in your agency, with the exception of those situate in townplots, and I have to ask you to be good enough to favour the Department at once with a complete list of the unsold lands in your agency, giving the lots in consecutive order in the different concessions in each township.
