PLANETS IN JANUARY, 1887.—The Sun is nearest the Earth on the 2nd; Uranus being 90° from the Sun on the same day. Venus is in Aphelion—farthest from the Sun—on the 8th. Saturn is at Opposition on the 9th, when he rises at sunset, is overhead at midnight and sets at dawn. The Moon is near him the same night. Jupiter is close to the Moon on the 16th, and 90° from the Sun on the 24th. Venus is near the Moon on the 25th; Luna passing Mars the same day.														
NOTE.—The third column gives the Moon's place in the "Signs," the cross heads give the Planets places, "Mars in Capricornus," etc., which denote the "Constellations."
