Dr. Earle, Bishop of Marlborough, and since 1900 Dean of Exeter, completed his eighty-fourth year recently. In spite of more than one recent illness, he is constantly at the cathedral he so dearly loves, and on the eve of his birthday he assisted in the "laying on of hands" and in administering the Holy Communion at the Ordination Service, and on Christmas morning he preached a plain sermon on home duties. It is forty years since he entered Exeter Diocese as Vicir of West Alvington. He became a Prebendary of the cathedral in 1872, a Residentiary Canon in 1885, and its Dean in 1900, and has served under five Bishops of Exeter: Philpotts, Temple, Bickersteth, Ryle and Robertson. From 1889 till 1900 he was away from the Diocese as the West London Suffragan.
