And a further sum of 10*l.* to the Ferryman on the eastern side of the Gut of Canso, to enable him to run a suitable Ferry Boat or Scow between Richard Carter's Landing, on the western side of said Gut, and David McPherson's on the eastern side thereof; the said Ferry Boat or Scow to be run under the regulation of the General Sessions for the County of Richmond.

And a further sum of 10*l.* each to such Persons as shall respectively keep up a Ferry at the Mouth of the Harbour of Port L'Herbert—provided a Boat be kept to convey Horses and Cattle across said Harbour—said sum to be paid upon the Certificate of the Court of Sessions in the County of Shelburne.

And a further sum of 20*l.* to Edmund Crowell, to enable him to keep up his Establishment at the Seal Islands, for the relief of Shipwrecked Mariners for the present year.

And a further sum of 15*l.* to Margaret Nickerson, to enable her to continue her Establishment for the accommodation of Travellers on the road from Barrington to Shelburne.

And a further sum of 23*l.* 1*s.* 8*d.* to Doctor Hoffman, for his services as Health Officer, for the Port of Halifax.
