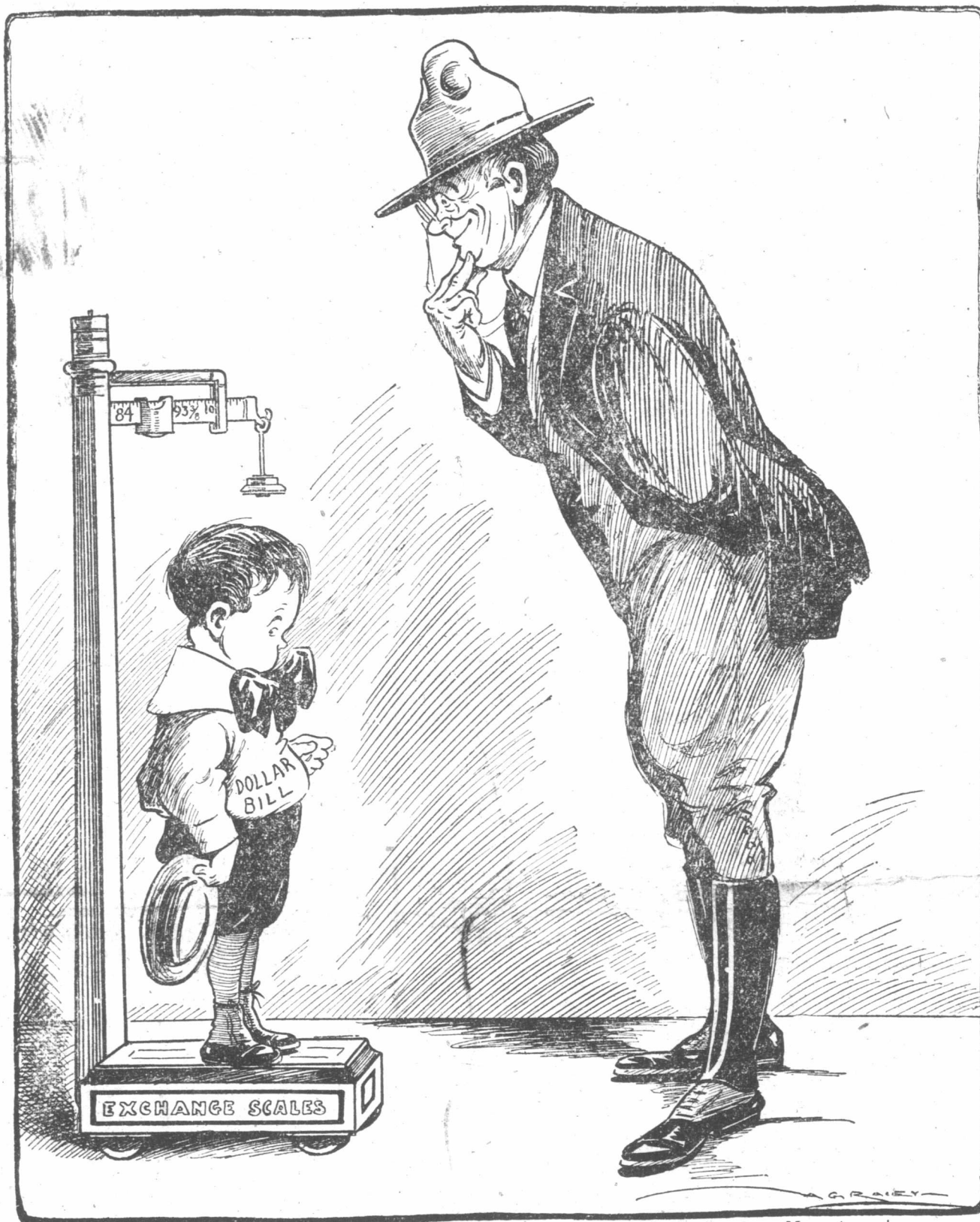
### Allies Must Act Broadly And Decisively

#### Lloyd George Talks

CANNES, Jan. 6.—Premier Lloyd George addressing the opening session of the Allied Supreme Council today warned the Allied powers that they could not look to any others but themselves to work out the economic rehabilitation of Europe. He appeared to the Allies to set aside prejudices and work together to this end. Mr. Lloyd George declared the Allies had reached the point where they must act decisively and broadly, if the economic structure of Europe was to be saved. "The Allies must make allowance for each other's opinions. Too much had been heard of individual claims and interests. All the Allies have just claims," the British Premier said. "I am not a pro-German apologist," he declared. "I have always said Germany must pay to the utmost limit of its capacity. But like lawyers we must consider the case and decide unanimously what measure must be taken to secure payment. The worst things the Allies could have done would have been to rush Germany into the same position as Russia is now, in where she would be in greater danger and where anarchy would be enthroned among a more efficient people. ### LATEST Aid France On Condition

DUBLIN, Jan. 7.—DE VALERA TO DAY BEFORE THE DAIL EIREANN, RESIGNED HIS POST AS PRESIDENT OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC. LATER, HOWEVER, HE WAS UNDERSTOOD TO SAY THAT HE WOULD POSTPONE HIS DECISION TO LEAVE OFFICE PENDING VOTE ON THE PEACE TREATY, IF THE VOTE WAS TAKEN IN FORTY EIGHT HOURS. HE COUPLED HIS RESIGNATION WITH THE STATEMENT THAT WHATEVER HAPPENED HE WOULD RETIRE TO PRIVATE LIFE, BUT ALMOST IN THE SAME BREATH HE SPOKE OF SELECTING A NEW CABINET IF HE WAS ELECTED CHIEF EXECUTIVE. FROM THESE CONFLICTING ASSERTIONS INFERENCE WAS DRAWN BY THOSE ATTENDING DAIL SESSIONS THAT IF TREATY WAS REJECTED DE VALERA WOULD REMAIN IN OFFICE AND ENDEAVOUR TO NEGOTIATE A NEW TREATY WITH THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT ON BASIS OF HIS ALTERNATIVE PROPOSALS. BUT THAT IF THE DAIL ACCEPTED THE TREATY HE WOULD DEFINITELY RETIRE FROM PUBLIC LIFE. THE DAIL ADJOURNED AT SEVEN O'CLOCK TO MEET TOMORROW AND A VOTE IS EXPECTED BY SATURDAY MORNING.

CANNES, Jan. 6.—Premier Lloyd George has declared there can be no question at this time of a formal alliance between France and Great Britain, it is learned on good authority, but he has held out prospects of a sufficient guarantee to aid France, if she is again attacked as in 1914, under certain conditions. These are, it is said, that France co-operate with Great Britain in the economic restoration of Europe and consent to modifications in the reparation payments of Germany.

LONDON, Jan. 6.—First step has been taken for severance of the Anglican Church in Australia from Church in England after three day's debate. A Sydney Times Australian Correspondent cables that the Anglican General Synod, which represents the whole commonwealth affirmed the principle of complete independence for Anglican Church in Australia as a National Church in the sense contemplated by the Thirty Nine Articles.

BELFAST, Jan. 7.—Commenting on De Valera's action in the Dail Eireann, the Evening Telegraph says "In flinging his resignation at head of Dail members, De Valera undoubtedly effected a sort of coup d'etat. Like Samson he laid hold of pillars of Dail, bowed himself with all his strength and put down the whole house of cards, burying himself in the debris. Ireland stands today humiliated before the world. The proceedings of the Dail have been simply protracted beer gardens, passers who with or without orders from their government violating existing international law on submarine warfare to be guilty of piracy."

WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—CONSULTATION ON THE SUBMARINE QUESTION WAS CONCLUDED TODAY BY THE FIVE POWERS NAVAL COMMITTEE WITH ADOPTION OF FINAL RESOLUTION, DECLARING SUBMARINE COMMANDERS WHO WITH OR WITHOUT ORDERS FROM THEIR GOVERNMENT VIOLATING EXISTING INTERNATIONAL LAW ON SUBMARINE WARFARE TO BE GUILTY OF PIRACY.

### No Peace In The Sinn Fein Cabinet And Resignations Follow

DUBLIN, Jan. 6.—Official announcement surrendered the political leadership, to the President, who had refused it. If the treaty was relieve, he added, the President could have any Cabinet he liked. The morning session had been hindered in receiving the report of the peace committee by three or four bullies. To loud cries of withdrawal, Collins responded, "I will withdraw, but the spoken word cannot be recalled." The House laughed. Collins declared the motion was simply a political dodge savouring of Tammany methods. Harry Boland said if Collins had any Tammany training he might have kept his bullying for Lloyd George. Charles Burgess said if Collins meant him as a bully his acceptance of the treaty would be measured by his estimate of the man making it and therefore he would take notice of it. De Valera explaining why he must resign said there must be some one in authority. A journalist had been kidnapped and Minister of Finance Collins had sent men to recover him. Collins had no right to send anybody. That was the function of the Minister of Defence Burgess. CANNES, Jan. 6.—The Allied Supreme Council decided today to hold European Economic Conference at Genoa during the first fortnight in March. The United States will be invited to participate. Russia will be asked to participate and this is regarded as amounting to recognition of the Soviet Government, moved for debate. Michael Collins said he had tendered his resignation to him, and Arthur Griffith who said he had tendered his resignation to the President, who had refused it.

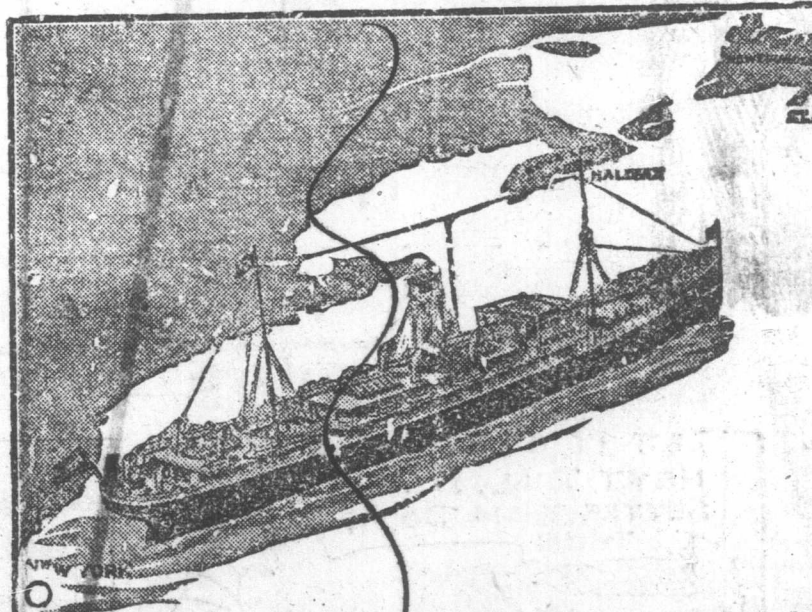
