THE TRAGEDY OF GRAFT.

Within the last few years three great public works for which the Dominion Government was responsible have, through inadequate precautions, or defective workmanship, crumbled or fallen into ruins, says the Winnipeg Telegram. The Laurier tower of the Parliament buildings at Ottawa crumbled into ruins, luckily without loss of life, but causing a heavy bill to Canadian taxpayers.

HIGHEST KIND OF COURAGE.
