terfered with owing to the want of concord on the question between the two companies concerned, and any person who at any time, before or after the election, is or has been employed at the same election or in any capacity as a canvasser for the purpose of forwarding the name of any candidate or any person whomsoever in any capacity whatsoever, to whomsoever or expects to receive his name, before, during, or after the said election, from any candidate or from any person in any such capacity as aforesaid, except only the returning officer, in the name of any candidate or in any capacity as aforesaid, shall be liable to a fine of not more than five pounds, or to imprisonment for not more than one month, or to both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court before whom he is tried.

SIR JOHN MACDONALD'S ANSWER TO MR. LISTER. Sir John Macdonald, in answer to Mr. Lister, said it was the intention of the Government to lay upon the table a copy of the regulations under which they propose to dispose of gold and silver mines in the North-West. The Department of the Interior was aware that valuable minerals had been discovered on Mackenzie, and an application had been made to the Department from the discoverers, the Healy or Dennis Company, for a location there. No grant, however, had been made to any other company until the regulations come in force, and no person has been authorized to grant mining licenses in the North-West.

connection, and go he did. The arrangement was in the first place temporary, and it is not yet of a permanent nature, but it is of a very great importance. It is not to be taken as a precedent. I think the happy fact of his acceptance of the position enabled him, from his peculiar knowledge of the country and its resources, to save the trade of Canada from a very great loss. (Hear, hear.) I am sure we cannot over-estimate the value of the concession my friend secured to Canada which he saved the live cattle trade of this country, which is now, perhaps the only country that has that trade with England. (Cheers.) My friend knows that in England it is not considered inconsistent for a Minister to act as a commissioner abroad. It is a matter of procedure. There was no inconsistency in Lord Beaconsfield going to Berlin, or in Lord John Russell going to the first treaty at Vienna, after the Crimean war, he being then Minister of Foreign Affairs. Then we all remember that the value of the concession was proved by the Government, of which he was a member, and the Vienna treaty was sanctioned by him as not ratified.

MR. MACDONALD.—We have a case in which a British Minister was sent as a resident ambassador to a foreign country. Sir JOHN MACDONALD.—Lord Castlereagh, a member of the Government, was in 1814 to Vienna and remained there as Minister during the whole year. He was not till the year 1815, when he returned to England, but he was resident there for a whole year, settling all the treaties consequent upon the fall of Napoleon, and there are other instances in which Ministers have acted as resident ambassadors. I do not think it is necessary to discuss this question, but I will furnish them with them if you wish. (Hear, hear.) The House adjourned at six o'clock.

In doing so, he complained that the St. John's, in 1882, gave the inspector arbitrary powers, which, without any appeal from his decision, a boat could be permanently stopped from running.
