The steamer must be from 80 to 100 tons net measurement, fitted with all modern improvements, and to have accommodation for about 20 cabin and 20 steerage passengers. This service, which will commence as soon as possible, will consist of one round trip each week and will be continuous throughout the whole of each year.

The steamer is to class "X 100 A1 at Lloyd's (England)" and to have a speed of at least ten knots. The contract to be for a term of ten years, to be computed from the date of commencement of the service. Tenders to specify the rate per round trip at which such service will be performed, which rate must include the board of the Government mail officer.

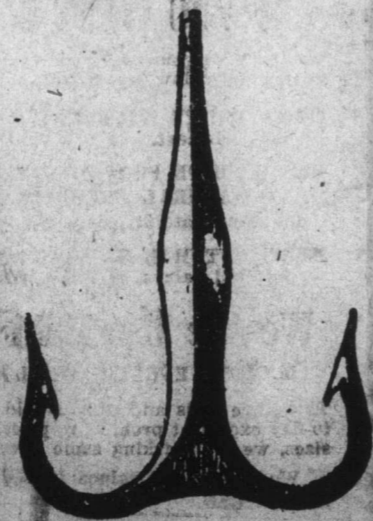
