CO MPLETE CALM IN FRANCE.

Frouble Brewing in Greece and Also in Bulgaria.

New York, Jan. 21.—Jacques St. Cere cables from Paris:
Complete calm continues to reign in France, and public opinion shows a greater indifference every day to what is taking place. It may almost be said tha France is divided into two countries, one of which is devoted to politics, while the other does not care a fig for political events.

The personality of the new President of the republic is little by little becoming manifest. He is a man of very great commercial intelligence and very liberal in politics, but he will not go very far in the direction of the Radicals.

M. Bourgeois will not complete his negotiations for a Cabinet until Monday, although most of the portfolios have been accepted. It is understood M. Hanotaux, Poincare and Barthou, all of the last Cabinet, and Eugene Godefroy Cavaignae have consented to serve. Gen. Mercier, Del Casse, Lockroy and Thompson are mentioned as candidates for the Ministry of Marine. M. Viger is another of M. Dupuy's colleagues who is willing to be a Minister again.

The general condition of Europe is peaceful, but there are some significant disorders in Greece, which would seem to indicate that a revolution is imminent in that country.

Bulgaria is almost the only subject which in this week of excited concentration of interest upon Paris and Versailles has been able to secure attention. As if there were not enough chances for trouble there already, sharp trouble with Austro-Hungary has arisen over the latter's claim that its citizens who reside in Bulgaria, are exempt from the trade taxes levied o nnative merchants under the Turkish laws called "Capitulations." This is true of all subjects of great powers, but if these rights are enforced, they render Bulgaria immediately bank-rupt. It is a small point in one way, but it contains germs of large possibilities and is worth watching.

CHINESE THE ATTACKING PARTY. Defeated After Eight Hours Hard Fighting at Hai-Chang.

Defeated After Eight Hours Hard Fighting at Hai-Chang.

Hiroshima, Japan, Jan. 20.—General Nodau, commander of the first Japan army, telegraphs as follows: The Chinese commenced an attack on Hai-Chang at 8 o'clock on the morning of Jan. 17, advancing from three roads. About acon they extended their front five miles, coming within 1500 metres of our advanced line. The third army division, after maintaining the defence of the north side of Hai-Chang until 4 p.m., assumed the offensive and attacked the enemy's right wing Shortly after 6 o'clock we succeeded in dispersing the Chinese. The enemy's strength was over 16,000. The main force is retreating north and west, and the remainder towards New Chwang. Seven guns were taken, besides other spoils.

Shanghaj, Jan. 20.—It is reported here on good authority that a part of the Japan fleet is bombarding the Ting-Chow, a short distance west of Che-Foo. No details have yet been received. The British warship Daphne and the American warship Yorktown are in the vicinity of Ting-Chow.

CLARA FORD'S TRIAL TO GO ON. An Application for its Postponement Un-til the Spring Assizes Refused by Judge Street.

Thronto, Jan. 21. — Clara Ford will be tried at the present assizes for the murder of Frank Westwood. The grand jury returned a true bill Saturday afternoon, and the accused girl was at once arraigned. She pleaded not guilty, and her counsel, Mr. Murdoch, moved before Mr. Justice Street to have the trial traversed until the March assizes.

It support of the motion for postponement Mr. Murdoch filed an affidavit made by the prisoner, in which she pleaded that a fair trial was impossible under the present state of public feeling, as an unprejudiced jury could not be had. The affidavit also sets forth that many witnesses, whose evidence would tell of the prisoner's movements in the night of the murder, had not yet been procured owing to a lack of funds.

His Lordship said the affidavit did not disclose any justification for postponement, and refused to grant the request. Mr. Justice MacMahon will on Monday fix the date of the trial.
