Dunraven's Boat Behind On the Outward sail and gained thirty on the return. The Vigilant and the Valkyrie were the only boats to finish.

New York, Oct. 7.—Bowling under a fair wind the American Cup defender, the Valkyrie, did her best today at 3:30 this afternoon, a winner in the first of the international races for the America's Cup.

They started promptly on time, and both boats were well handled. The Vigilant was the winner by 5 minutes and 48 seconds.

On the way to the outer mark the boats sailed free, either running, or on a free reach. The wind held at the outer mark.

Both victor and vanquished were cheered and saluted at the finish, and the Vigilant and the Valkyrie were the only boats to finish.
