DOMINION PARLIAMENT.

The estimates were brought down on Friday. The total estimated expenditure is \$35,410,800. Of the appropriations for rivers and harbors \$2,500,000 is received. \$2,100,000; New Brunswick, \$24,500,000; P. E. Island, \$1,000,000; Quebec, \$24,500,000; Ontario, \$20,250,000; British Columbia, \$24,500,000. For dredging generally, \$1,000,000 is appropriated. For a grant of \$1,500,000 for steamship service between Halifax and St. John via Yarmouth has been dropped, and a subsidy for communication between Grand Manan and the mainland is reduced by \$200,000. There are to be voted for a line of steamers to ply between Halifax and St. John via Yarmouth, and a full account of the same is given in the Monitor.

Philadelphia, Pa., Feb. 10.—The extensive establishment of John Wreth & Co., manufacturing chemists, 1413 to 16 Walnut street, was burned today. The loss is between \$200,000 and \$300,000, nearly covered by insurance. During the progress of the fire the central portion of the double building fell, burying several persons.
